

The typefaces (e.g., italics and large/small caps) used in the citations in the Bluebook apply to the final, printed version of articles, **not** the manuscript (draft) version. But you will be editing manuscript pages, not final pages., Therefore:

- Text that appears in **italics** in the Bluebook should appear **underlined** in the Edit.
- Text that appears in **large/small caps** in the Bluebook should appear in **bold** in the Edit.
- Text should **never** appear in italics or large/small caps on the Edit.

Here's an example, based on a citation on page 139 of the Bluebook:

Kim Lane Scheppele, *Foreword: Telling Stories*, 87 MICH. L. REV. 2073, 2082 (1989).

If this citation appeared correctly on the Writing Competition Edit, it would look like this:

Kim Lane Scheppele, Foreword: Telling Stories, 87 **Mich. L. Rev.** 2073, 2082 (1989).

If the text on the page looks like this:	Correct it like this:
